Notice for Sensory Motor Evaluation/ Vision Therapy Evaluation Patients

Welcome to our office. You have requested an appointment or have been referred for a Sensory Motor/Vision Therapy Evaluation. The goal of this evaluation is to determine if there is a functional or visual perceptual concern relating to academic difficulties, job related discomfort and inefficiency, athletic difficulties or difficulties with daily activities that would benefit from Vision Therapy. If you have not had a routine eye exam in the last year, this examination will be performed prior to the Sensory Motor Evaluation because there must be a knowledge of baseline needs to further assess the need for therapy. Some or all of the sensory motor testing may be completed at the time of the initial visit, however, a second visit may be required. All visual examinations will be covered under your appropriate vision plan if you have routine vision care.

The following guidelines refer to medical coverage for Vision Therapy Evaluations:

The Vision Therapy Evaluation is typically divided into an evaluation of eye teaming, focusing and if necessary, an evaluation of eye movement skills and visual perceptual skills.

If a complete visual perceptual evaluation is indicated it will be performed at a separate visit.

Please be advised that when an appropriate medical diagnosis such as Convergence Insufficiency, any type of eye turn or Amblyopia (lazy eye) is evident, the sensory motor aspect of your evaluation may typically (but not always) be covered under your medical plan. If the prevailing diagnosis is not related to a medically covered condition your medical plan will not cover the Sensory Motor Evaluation and you will be billed our usual and customary fees.

Any testing done to evaluate eye movement skills and visual perceptual skills will be billed independent of the Sensory Motor Evaluation as these are not covered expenses under any medical plan.
